

Predicted Alcohol Crash Stats Louisiana



On average, from 2020-2024, there were 310 fatalities and 391 suspected serious injuries per year.



14% decrease in Louisiana alcohol involved fatal driving crashes in 2024 from 2020.



Drivers between the ages of 25-34 have the highest number of fatalities resulting from alcohol involved crashes.

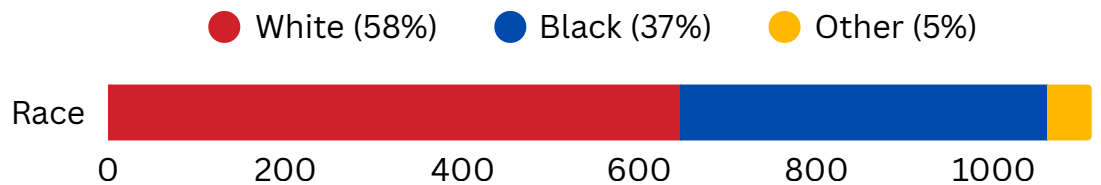


218 passengers died in alcohol involved crashes from 2020-2024.

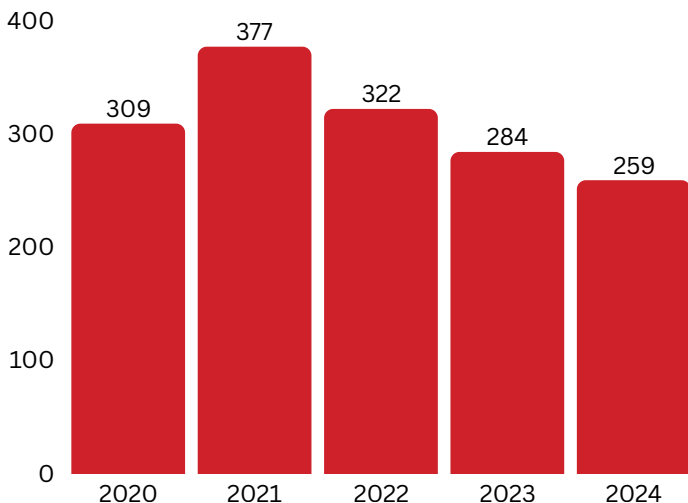


81% of drivers killed in alcohol involved crashes from 2020-2024 were male.

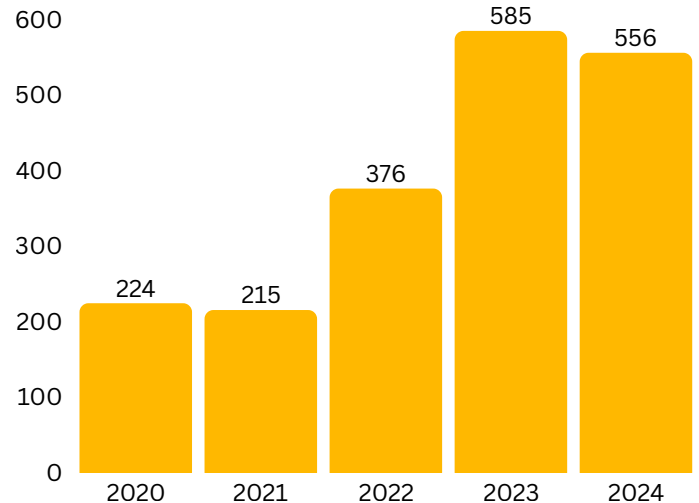
Predicted Alcohol Crash Fatalities By Race
